# Anointing of the Holy Spirit

## Indwelling of the Holy Spirit

You can repent of your sins and be baptized into the baptism of John receiving the indwelling of the Holy Spirit, but still not have the baptism of the Holy Spirit.

 Acts 19:2-3

“Have you received the Holy Spirit since you believed?” They said to him, “No, we have not even heard that there is a Holy Spirit.” He said to them, “Into what then were you baptized?” They said, “Into John’s baptism.”

# Baptism of the Holy Spirit

Jesus commanded His disciples to wait for His promise of the Holy Spirit. He didn't tell them how they would know they had received it because He knew it would be an experience.

## Act 1:4-5

Being assembled with them, He [Jesus] commanded them, "Do not depart from Jerusalem, but wait for the promise of the Father, of which you have heard from Me. For John baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now."

The baptism of the Holy Spirit is always an experience you brings transformation and sets you on fire for God.

## Act 2:1-4

When the day of Pentecost had arrived, they were all together in one place. Suddenly a sound like that of a violent rushing wind came from heaven, and it filled the whole house where they were staying. They saw tongues like flames of fire that separated and rested on each one of them. Then they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues, as the Spirit enabled them.

Immersion in the Holy Spirit should change your life to such a degree people around you can tell a change has occurred.

## Acts 2:5-8

Now dwelling in Jerusalem were Jews, devout men, from every nation under heaven. When this sound occurred, the crowd came together and were confounded, because each man heard them speaking in his own language. They were all amazed and marveled, saying to each other, Are not all these who are speaking Galileans? How is it that we hear, each in our own native language?
